East Passyunk Crossing Community Garden Application

East Passyunk Crossing Community Garden is an organic style garden on the site of Neumann-Goretti campus in the heart of our community. A number of raised bed plots are available for gardening on site. Gardening here is a privilege, but it is also a commitment. Not only will members receive their own plots, but will be investing in and committing to the maintenance of the garden at large. You will be required to attend an opening and closing work day of about 4 hours each (held in April and November, respectively) as well as two (2) of our monthly scheduled workdays of two hours each at some point during the season, at your discretion. Gardeners who do not maintain their plots properly or do not contribute to these workdays will lose gardening privileges, so please make sure you will have the time to commit not only to your own plot, but these additional hours over the season.

\$70 fee (\$50 annual dues, \$20 deposit). If this is a hardship, contact us as there may be funds available to help cover the cost. At this time we can accept cash or a check made out to East Passyunk Crossing Civic Association. Plot fees must be paid on or before the first garden workday, announced annually in spring.

Applications are not considered complete unless the applicant reads and agrees to the Rules and Regulations and pays the plot fee and deposit.

Applications will be accepted based on availability or put on the waitlist. All plots after the initial distribution will be based on a first come, first serve basis as determined by the waitlist. Allocation will be based purely on the discretion of Garden Leadership along with Beautification Committee Leadership.
